

IMPACT:

- ▶ 130 People living with HIV received ART medicines at their doorstep, enabling them to lead a healthy life.

- ▶ 30000 grocery kits distributed to migrants and other marginalised communities during Covid 19.

CURRENT PROJECTS:



• Truckers - HIV Project with support from Maharashtra State AIDS Control Society (2019 - 2023):

1,20,000 truck drivers and workers such as cleaners and helpers in APMC market area, Navi Mumbai have been supported with HIV prevention, treatment and care services such as HIV testing, STI screening and treatment, condom distribution and behaviour change communication sessions.

• Female Sex Workers (FSWs) HIV Project with support from Maharashtra State AIDS Control Society (2022-2024):

2000 FSWs from Budhwar Peth, India's third major FSW brothel-based location are receiving basic HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment and referral services. They are also screened for non-communicable diseases like breast cancer and cervical cancer. Additionally, Manthan Foundation also facilitates their access to social entitlements and welfare schemes such as Aadhaar card, PAN card, Ration card and Sanjay Gandhi Niradhar Pension Yojana.



• Work with Transgender Population (Since 2019)

Free health check-up camps and behaviour change communication sessions along with condom distribution are regularly organized for transgender population in

urban and rural areas of Pune district; 200+ transgenders have benefitted from this initiative. Manthan Foundation is part of the committee formed by Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) for the upliftment of transgenders.

• Devbhumi Project (Aug 2022 – July 2023):

6000 people would be made aware of non-communicable diseases (NCDs) and 3000 individuals above the age of 30 will be screened for diabetes and hypertension in five villages of Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand and provided with referral services. The project would also focus on formation of SHGs and livelihood opportunities for women and life skills education for children.

• Project 'Act on NCD' (Sept 2022 – July 2023):

3000 Female Sex Workers, their Partners and Transgenders above the age of 30+ would be screened for diabetes and hypertension and provided with referral services.



• Annapura Project in collaboration with Maha-NGO Federation (Aug 2022 – July 2023):

In collaboration with Maha-NGO Federation, this project started from 15 August 2022 to distribute dry groceries among 90 Female Sex workers living with HIV to help them with dietary needs. This is a one year Project intended to be functional by July 2023.



• 'YOGA Teacher' diploma course in collaboration with Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (Since 2020):

90 students have completed the one year diploma course in YOGA; some of them have started their own classes.



• Environment Preservation in collaboration with Forest Department:

2000+ trees have been planted and awareness sessions on snake bites have been organized in snake prone areas. Manthan Foundation regularly organizes events to create awareness on environment issues such as afforestation, solid

waste management, water management and promoting use of public transport and bicycles.



PAST PROJECTS:

• Pre-Exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) study: (July 2021 - March 2022):

Manthan Foundation has supported National AIDS Research Institute (NARI), Central Government to reach Transgender Population for creating awareness about the PrEP and get them enrolled in the study. The project reached 110 transgenders; 26 of them have enrolled in the study successfully.

• Project Accelerate in collaboration with YRG care (Jan 2021 – Sept 2022):

150 MSMs (Men having sex with Men) and Transgenders from Khed block of Pune were mobilized and enrolled for the project 'Accelerate', a pilot initiative to establish a pick-up point for HIV self testing and PrEP (Pre Exposure Prophylaxis).

• Project 'LINKAGES' in collaboration with FHI 360 (2018-2019):

Supported Humsafar Trust and Aastha Parivar to reach 525 FSWs, Men having sex with Men (MSMs), and Transgenders in the rural and urban areas of the Pune district.

• Orphan and Vulnerable Children (OVC) program in collaboration with YRG CARE (Dec 2020 – Mar 2022):

Awareness sessions on health and life skills were conducted and 150+ children living with HIV (CLHIV) and their caregivers have been supported with dry groceries and nutritious food.

• Working on Rights of the Children in collaboration with Action for the Rights of the Child (Since 2020):

Manthan Foundation has persistently advocated for child rights and child education through numerous against child labour, child sexual exploitation and child beggary.

• Conducted solo Cycle Expedition for Environment and Health Awareness:

• Organized a 13 days HIV/AIDS rally with the theme 'KNOW YOUR STATUS' on the occasion of World AIDS day in 10 districts of Maharashtra in 2018 - Pune, Solapur, Latur, Buldhana, Beed, Nanded, Hingoli, Akola, Washim, and Parbhani, under the supervision of cyclist Mr. Niranjan Welankar; 25000 people were made aware about HIV/AIDS.

• Organized a 26 days rally to create awareness on health and environment in 2019 from Shimla-Kaza-Tso Moriri-Leh (1200 kms); 15000 people were made aware and meetings with key stakeholders such as NGOs, CBOs and Government authorities participated along the way.

• COVID 19 Pandemic Relief Activity:

• Distributed 30000 grocery kits to migrant workers and other marginalized people in collaboration with the Maha-NGO Federation, SANY Heavy Industry India Pvt. Ltd., L'Oreal India Pvt. Ltd. and ITC Limited.

• Provided support to 45000 migrants to relocate to their native towns/villages in coordination with the Pune District Collector and Governor of Maharashtra to further provided.

• Organized regular Health Camps, Yoga Camps and arranged for Kadha Distribution.

• Organized awareness session about Covid 19, Setu App, Covid testing and care.

• Supported the district authorities in taking decisions on the distribution of Remdesivir and setting up systems in the rural areas.

• Mobilized 1500 FSWs and TGs and 2500 migrants and industrial workers for Covid 19 vaccination.

NITI Aayog has recognized the work of the Manthan Foundation during the pandemic and published our story in their newsletter in May 2020.

- ACT on NCDs project: Target to screen for diabetes and hypertension of 100000 individuals by 2024
- Vocational training for 5000 students by 2024
